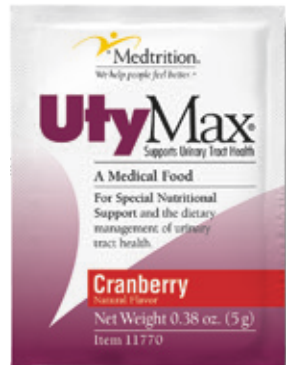

FOR THE PREVENTION OF RECURRENT URINARY TRACT INFECTIONS

In a randomized, controlled clinical trial, 137 women who experienced two or more UTIs treated with antibiotic in the previous 12 months were selected to receive either 500 mg of Cran-Max[®] or 100 mg of trimethoprim per day for six months. The researchers found that the time of first recurrence of the UTI was not significantly different between groups. The researchers concluded that in the first head-to-head, double-blind comparison of cranberry versus antibiotic prophylaxis, trimethoprim had a very limited advantage over Cran-Max in the prevention of recurrent UTIs in older women, while Cran-Max produced none of the adverse effects associated with trimethoprim, including diarrhea, upset stomach and yeast infection. In addition, trimethoprim is contraindicated for warfarin and should not be taken together.^{27,28,29}

UtyMax[®] is a medical food. Use under supervision of a qualified healthcare professional.

Dosing: UtyMax should be used prophylactically to prevent recurrent urinary tract infections. It can be used in conjunction with antibiotics..

Oral: Mix one packet with 120 mL (4 oz.) of water or other suitable fluid. Stir and drink. Can be used once or twice a day.

Tube Feeding: Mix one packet with 30 mL of water. Stir until completely dissolved. Infuse via syringe down feeding tube. Flush tube with 15-30 mL water before and after administration. **Do not mix with tube feeding formula.**

Ingredients: Nutriose[®] (soluble dietary fiber), Cran-Max Micronized, Citric Acid, Malic Acid, Natural and Artificial Flavors, Ascorbic Acid, Cherry Red Powder (color), Sucralose.
